We invite submissions to the Fifth unibz Workshop on Political Economy, which will be held at the Bruneck-Brunico branch of the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano on Friday, November 26th and Saturday, November 27th, 2021.

The workshop aims at bringing together scholars studying the economic causes and consequences of political phenomena and institutions.

We encourage submissions of theoretical and empirical papers from economics and political science, with a particular emphasis on topics related to:

- Political economy and geography.
- Political economy of transportation and infrastructures.
- Political economy of populism.
- Political economy of conflict.

We welcome submission of unpublished papers and extended abstracts for work in progress. Submissions should be sent by October 10, 2021, to federico.boffa@unibz.it.
