Call for Papers

We invite submissions to the Sixth UniBZ Workshop on Political Economy, which will be held at the Bruneck-Brunico branch of the Free University of Bozen-Bolzano on Thursday, November 9th and Friday, November 10th, 2023.

The workshop aims at bringing together scholars studying the economic causes and consequences of political phenomena and institutions. We encourage submissions of theoretical and empirical papers from economics and political science, with a particular emphasis on topics related to:

- Political economy and geography.
- The political economy of transportation and infrastructure.
- The political economy of populism.
- The political economy of conflict.
- The political economy of reforms.

We welcome submission of unpublished papers and extended abstracts for work in progress. Submissions should be sent by September 10, 2023, to [federico.boffa@unibz.it](mailto:federico.boffa@unibz.it) and [gponzetto@crei.cat](mailto:gponzetto@crei.cat)

Authors of accepted papers will be notified by September, 20, 2023.
